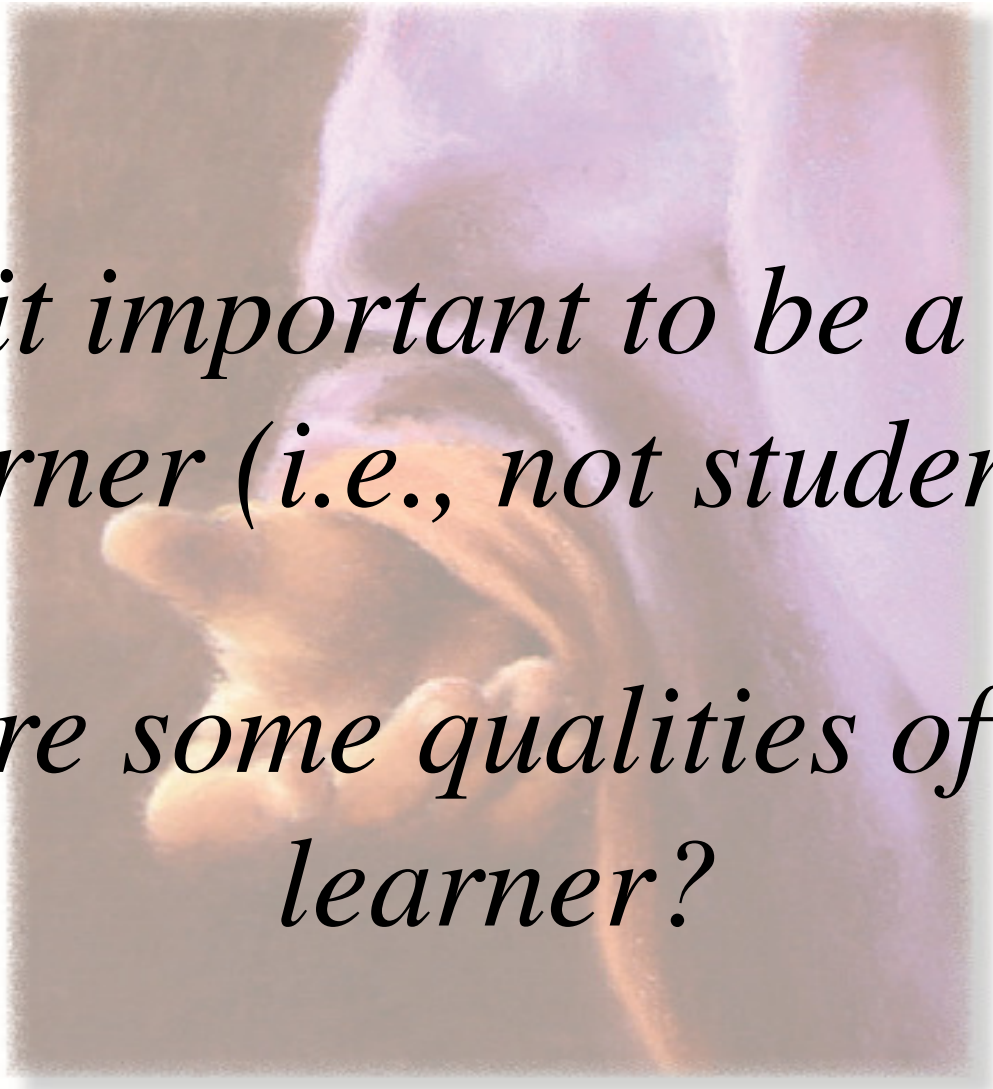

# KEY LESSONS

1. Develop a God-centered understanding of sovereignty (six principles)
  1. Much of God's plan is unknown to us
  2. God is in control of everything
  3. God acts according to His plan, purpose and good pleasure
  4. God's plan is unconditional and certain
  5. God's plan is comprehensive and eternal
  6. God's plan is directed toward His glory

# KEY LESSONS

2. Maintain an eternal perspective
3. Trust God's wisdom and goodness without question or blame

# KEY LESSONS
