Week 1	<b>50. How could Christ suffer?</b> <i>Christ, the Son of God, became a man so that he could obey and suffer in our place.</i>	16 So He came to Nazareth, where He had been brought up. And as His custom was, He went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day, and stood up to read.
Week 2	<b>51. For whom did Christ obey and suffer?</b> <i>For all whom God the Father gave to Christ.</i>	
Week 3	<b>52. What kind of life did Christ live on earth?</b> <i>A life of obedience, service and suffering.</i>	17 And He was handed the book of the prophet Isaiah. And when He had opened the book, He found the place where it was written:
Week 4	<b>53. What kind of death did Jesus die?</b> <i>The painful and shameful death of the cross.</i>	18 “ The Spirit of the LORD is upon Me, Because He has anointed Me To preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives And recovery of sight to the blind, To set at liberty those who are oppressed;
Week 5	<b>54. How many offices does Christ fulfill as the promised Messiah?</b> <i>Christ fulfills three offices.</i>	
Week 6	<b>55. What are they?</b> <i>The offices of a prophet, of a priest, and of a king.</i>	
Week 7	<b>56. How is Christ your prophet?</b> <i>Christ teaches me the will of God.</i>	
Week 8	<b>57. How is Christ your priest?</b> <i>Christ died for my sins and continues to pray for me.</i>	
Week 9	<b>58. How is Christ your king?</b> <i>Christ rules over me, the world and Satan, and he defends me.</i>	
Week 10	<b>59. Why do you need Christ as your prophet?</b> <i>Because I am ignorant by nature.</i>	19 To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD.”
Week 11	<b>60. Why do you need Christ as your priest?</b> <i>Because I am guilty of breaking God's law.</i>	20 Then He closed the book, and gave it back to the attendant and sat down. And the eyes of all who were in the synagogue were fixed on Him.
Week 12	<b>61. Why do you need Christ as your king?</b> <i>Because I am weak and helpless.</i>	21 And He began to say to them, “Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing.”
Week 13	<i>Recite answers 50-53; 68-75</i>	22 So all bore witness to Him, and marveled at the gracious words which proceeded out of His mouth. And they said, “Is this not Joseph’s son?”
