What else did God give Adam and Eve besides bodies? He gave them souls that will last forever.</p> <p>20. Do you have a soul as well as a body? Yes. And my soul is going to last forever.</p> <p>21. How do you know your soul will last forever? Because the Bible tells me so.</p> <p>22. In what condition did God make Adam and Eve? He made them holy and happy.</p> <p>23. What covenant did God make with Adam? The covenant of life.</p> <p>24. What is a covenant? A relationship that God establishes with us and guarantees by his word.</p> <p>25. In the covenant of life, what did God require Adam to do? To obey God perfectly.</p> <p>26. What did God promise in the covenant of life? To reward Adam with life if he obeyed God perfectly.</p> <p>27. What did God threaten in the covenant of life? To punish Adam with death if he disobeyed God.</p> <p>28. Did Adam keep the covenant of life? No. He sinned against God.</p> <p>29. What is sin? Sin is any lack of conformity to, or transgression of, the law of God.</p> <p>30. What is meant by lack of conformity? Not being or doing what God requires.</p> <p>31. What is meant by transgression? Doing what God forbids.</p> <p>32. What does every sin deserve? The wrath and curse of God.</p> <p>33. What was the sin of our first parents? Eating the forbidden fruit.</p> <p>34. Who tempted Adam and Eve to this sin? Satan tempted Eve first, and then he used her to tempt Adam.</p> <p>35. How did Adam and Eve change when they sinned? Instead of being holy and happy, they became sinful and miserable.</p> <p>36. Did Adam act for himself alone in the covenant of life? No. He represented the whole human race.</p> <p>37. What effect did the sin of Adam have on all people? We are all born guilty and sinful.</p> <p>38. How sinful are you by nature? I am corrupt in every part of my being.</p> <p>Q. 39. What is the sinful nature that we inherit from Adam called?
